These children may be brought to court due to violence, psychological torment or sexual abuse. CASA ensures the child has a voice in court, finding out the best environment for the child when the case is resolved.

The art supplies, donated by Hanna's Dream, Inc. will be distributed to the many children served by the local CASA. Due to the significant amount of art supplies donated, CASA will be holding an Art Fair on August 24, 2009.
